

Retention, Placement, On-Time Completion, and Graduation Rates for Stautzenberger College - Brecksville

You may find it helpful to have information* about how Stautzenberger College, Brecksville assists its students to complete their programs and find employment in their fields of interest. One of the ways to understand this is to consider how many students remain enrolled in their programs from year-to-year (“Retention Rates”). This information is measured from July 1 to June 30 each year.

You may also find it helpful to know how many of the students who graduated between July 1 and June 30 of any given academic year find employment by September 15 each year (“Placement Rates”). A placement is measured by whether a graduate finds a position in the field(s) in which he/she studied. Stautzenberger College, Brecksville considers a graduate placed “in field” or “in a related field” only if he/she is using the skills learned in a position that requires those skills, carries that job title, or has a job description that falls within that SOC Code as defined by the United States Department of Labor. Graduates who are working in positions that do not carry the job title, job description or require the skills specific to the field studied are categorized as “employed out of field.” Graduates are only counted as placed if the College were able to verify employment.

The information that follows describes both of these numbers for the last five years for Stautzenberger College, Brecksville. This information is campus-specific, and does not include other locations of Stautzenberger College.

*Please note: The College reports information to three primary regulatory sources—the United States Department of Education, the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools, and the Ohio State Board of Career Colleges and Schools. Each of these bodies asks for slightly different kinds of information, so some numbers may differ. ACICS Statistics

The following information is derived from data submitted to the Accrediting Council for Independent Colleges and Schools each year in the College’s Annual Institutional Report (also known as the Campus Accountability Report) for Stautzenberger College, Brecksville. 76.9% (610 enrolled during period; 114 graduated; 355 still enrolled at end of period)

82.9% (509 enrolled during period; 78 graduated; 340 still enrolled at end of period)

2007-2008

76.5% (419 enrolled during period; 36 graduated; 283 still enrolled at end of period)

2006-2007

76.5% (297 enrolled during period; 4 graduated; 211 still enrolled at end of period)

ACICS Placement Rates

Graduates are not counted in the denominator if they are unavailable for placement for reasons of continuing education, military service, etc.

Placement Rates Across All Programs:

2010-2011

Placement = 77.9% (82 graduates; 31 employed in field; 29 employed in related field; 9 employed out of field; 5 continuing their education and therefore not available for placement; and 8 could not be confirmed as working)

2009-2010

Placement = 68.2% (114 graduates; 72 employed in field; 3 employed in related field; 19 employed out of field; 4 continuing their education and therefore not available for placement; and 16 could not be confirmed as working)

2008-2009

Placement = 81.9% (78 graduates; 55 placed in field, 4 in a related field, 5 outside of field, 6 unavailable for placement because of health or continuing education, and 8 could not be confirmed working)

2007-2008

Placement = 91.7% (36 graduates; 31 placed in field, 2 in a related field, 1 outside of field, 2 could not be confirmed working)

State of Ohio Placement Rates

The State of Ohio Board of Career Colleges and Schools calculates placement rates slightly differently than does ACICS. Below are the placement rates for Stautzenberger College, Brecksville as calculated by the State of Ohio. This information is campus-specific, and does not include other locations of Stautzenberger College. Graduates are not counted in the denominator if they are unavailable for placement for reasons of continuing education, military service, could not be reached, etc.

Institutional Placement Rates:

2010-2011

Placement = 80% (82 graduates; 60 employed in field or in a related field; 9 employed out of field; 7 not available for placement; and 6 could not be confirmed as working)

2009-2010

Placement = 75% (114 graduates; 72 employed in field or in a related field; 19 employed out of field; 14 not available for placement; and 6 could not be confirmed as working)

2008-2009

Placement = 81.9% (78 graduates; 55 placed in field, 4 in a related field, 5 outside of field, 6 not available for placement, and 8 could not be confirmed as working)

2007-2008

Placement = 94.3% (35 graduates; 31 placed in field, 2 in a related field, 2 could not be confirmed as working)

Graduation Rates

2007

Stautzenberger College, Brecksville's 2007 First-Time Full-Time Graduation Rate as reported to the National Center for Educational Statistics (IPEDS) was 56% (25 students in adjusted cohort; 14 completers within 150% of the normal time). The College's 2007 Transfer-Out Rate as reported to the National Center for Educational Statistics (IPEDS) was 16% (25 students in the adjusted cohort; 4 students transferring to a different institution of higher education).

On-Time Completion Rate

2010-2011 The following programs had graduates in the reporting year.

Broadcast Captioning Associate Degree

Stautzenberger College, Brecksville graduated fewer than 10 captioners in the 2010-2011 academic year. It cannot by law provide completion information for fewer than 10 graduates.

Court Reporting Associate Degree

Stautzenberger College, Brecksville graduated fewer than 10 court reporters in the 2010-2011 academic year. It cannot by law provide completion information for fewer than 10 graduates.

Massage Therapy Associate Degree

Stautzenberger College, Brecksville graduated fewer than 10 captioners in the 2010-2011 academic year. It cannot by law provide completion information for fewer than 10 graduates.

Paralegal Studies Associate Degree

This program graduated 63.6% of its graduates in the 24 months allotted to complete the program by a student attending full-time. Students attending part-time will generally take longer to complete the program.

Veterinary Technology Associate Degree

This program graduated 35.8% of its graduates in the 27 months allotted to complete the program by a student attending full-time. Students attending part-time will generally take longer to complete the program.
